## 1940s DINING CHAIR



### ➤ DIMENSIONS

H: 80cm

W: 45cm

D: 56cm

### ➤ MATERIALS

Oak framework with clients' own 1.75 sq/m of leather or 2 metres of fabric/material per chair.

### ➤ HAND FINISHES & PATINATION

Upholstered seat with a light, mid, dark or ebonised finish.

### ➤ FIRE RETARDANCY

All upholstery foams and linings comply with UK fire regulations. Client to arrange for own fabric/leather to be fire treated, if necessary.

### ➤ HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR PRODUCT

For the framework, dust with a lint-free cloth. If polishing is required, use Renaissance Wax (if compatible with the finish applied – check with us). Avoid any acidic, silicone or harsh abrasive cleaners (e.g. Cif or Mr. Sheen). Apply sparingly with a soft, lint-free cloth. Remove excess with a second clean cloth.

If the upholstery is leather, ensure that you do not leave the item of furniture in direct sunlight for prolonged periods. Avoid direct heat from fires and radiators which can dry out and distort the leather. Do not use saddle soap, wax polishes or general household cleaning products. Chemicals are not recommended as they break down the protective surface.
