



## ➤ DIMENSIONS

Small: Diameter: 120cm x H: 75cm Large: L: 160cm x W: 120cm x H: 75cm

Extending: Diameter: 120cm (L: 160cm when extended) x H: 75cm

## ➤ MATERIALS

Oak, steel and brass/copper/zinc.

## ➤ HAND FINISHES & PATINATION

Lacquered natural oak finish and choice of a medium mottled brass, copper or zinc table top with a satin lacquer. Powder coated steel base.

## > HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR PRODUCT

If unlacquered, brass will discolour if ferrous metals such as steel are placed on it for long periods of time. Brass is an organic material and will react to its environment. Spots will form, but over time they will fade and self-correct. With use, the characteristic of brass will develop and it may take up to a year to acquire a full patina. To maintain the appearance of the patinated brass use Carnauba Wax. Rub in sparingly with a soft, lint-free cloth. Wipe off excess with a second cloth.

If the brass is lacquered, wipe down evenly with a lint-free cloth. For cleaning use a mild soap (e.g. Fairy) on a well wrung-out lint-free cloth.

Any marks on the steel are to be removed with a dry cloth and any spillages are to be dried immediately as moisture can cause rust. To maintain the appearance of the steel use Carnauba Wax. Rub in sparingly with a soft, lint-free cloth. Wipe off excess with a second cloth.
