## BRAQUE OVERMANTEL MIRROR



### ➤ DIMENSIONS

Small: H: 130cm x W: 100cm x D: 2.5cm  
Medium: H: 155cm x W: 125cm x D: 2.5cm  
Large: H: 170cm x W: 135cm x D: 2.5cm

### ➤ MATERIALS

Brass and antiqued mirror glass.

### ➤ HAND FINISHES & PATINATION

Medium patinated brass with a satin lacquer. Lightly antiqued mirror glass.

### ➤ HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR PRODUCT

If unlacquered, brass is an organic material and will react to its environment. Spots will form, but over time they will fade and self-correct. With use, the characteristic of brass will develop and it may take up to a year to acquire a full patina. To maintain the appearance of the bright brass use Brasso Metal Polish. Apply with a soft cloth and polish with a dry soft cloth before the polish has completely dried. Repeat if necessary.

To clean the antiqued mirror glass, lightly spray the cloth with a proprietary non-smear glass cleaner. Hodgson Sealants glass cleaner is recommended. Rub the damp lint-free cloth over the surface of the glass to remove the dirt. Using a second cloth, polish the surface of the glass. Repeat the procedure if necessary. Ensure that any cloths used are checked for grit or dust that could scratch the glass.

### ➤ HANDLING & FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

The mirror is to be fitted on split battens which are situated on the back of the mirror ready. The wall should be assessed prior to installation to see what the make up is. It is important that the split battens that are fixed to the wall are installed level and secure before lifting the mirror onto them. It is recommended to wear gloves when handling the brass frames.
