

BRASS CHEVRON MIRROR



> DIMENSIONS

Small: H: 92cm x W: 72cm x D: 3.5cm Medium: H: 112cm x W: 92cm x D: 3.5cm Large: H: 132cm x W: 112cm x D: 3.5cm

MATERIALS

Oak, antiqued mirror glass and brass.

► HAND FINISHES & PATINATION

Fumed oak and oiled frame. Lightly patinated brass with a satin lacquer. Lightly antiqued mirror glass.

► HOW TO CARE FOR YOUR PRODUCT

If unlacquered, brass is an organic material and will react to its environment. Spots will form, but over time they will fade and self-correct. With use, the characteristic of brass will develop and it may take up to a year to acquire a full patina. To maintain the appearance of the bright brass use Brasso Metal Polish. Apply with a soft cloth and polish with a dry soft cloth before the polish has completely dried. Repeat if necessary.

To clean the antiqued mirror glass, lightly spray the cloth with a proprietary non-smear glass cleaner. Hodgson Sealants glass cleaner is recommended. Rub the damp lindt-free cloth over the surface of the glass to remove the dirt. Using a second cloth, polish the surface of the glass. Repeat the procedure if necessary. Ensure that any cloths used are checked for grit or dust that could scratch the glass.
